# MEXICO IN TEXAS, AND THE ORGANIZATION TEXAS COURT APPOINTED SPECIAL ADVOCATES FOR CHILDREN REGARDING MUTUAL COLLABORATION IN CASES OF MEXICAN MINORS OR CHILDREN OF MEXICAN ORIGIN WHO ARE IN CUSTODY OF THE STATE CHILD PROTECTIVE SERVICES UNDER THE COLLABORATIVE FAMILY ENGAGEMENT INITIATIVE.

The Consulates of Mexico in Texas ("the Consulate") and the organization Texas Court Appointed Special Advocates for children (Texas CASA) hereinafter referred as "the Parties";

**CONSIDERING** Mexican children and families as a fundamental element of the Mexican communities established in the United States and, in particular, in the State of Texas;

**RECOGNIZING** the importance of the presence of family for a child well-being, specifically for those children in the care of state child protective services, regardless of the nationality either from the child or their family;

**CONSCIOUS** of the need to work together to better treat cases involving Mexican Minors under the state care of child protective services, including collaborative efforts to find and work with Mexican families, whether they reside in the United States or in Mexico;

**TAKING INTO ACCOUNT** that there are Mexican communities throughout Texas which may require the assistance of their Consulate in order to better understand child protection proceedings and the resources available to improve safety and permanency for children in Texas;

Have agreed to the following terms and conditions:

#### I. PURPOSE OF COLLABORATION AND OBJECTIVES

The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is to establish a collaborative framework between the Parties to work together in cases of Mexican children or children of Mexican origin who are in custody of the Texas state child protective services, and whose cases are included in the Texas CASA Collaborative Family Engagement initiative.

The objectives of this collaboration are:

- A. To connect each child with a family, even when the family might live abroad, so that every child may benefit from the connections and support that family provides.
- B. To encourage mutual collaboration and open communication between the Parties regarding cases of Mexican minors or children of Mexican origin, bearing in mind the best interest of the child.
- C. To promote and support best practices of collaborative work in cases involving any child of a Mexican family.

#### II. DEFINITIONS

For the purposes of this MOU, the following definitions apply.

- A. "CASA volunteer" refers to the volunteer appointed by the Court to advocate for the best interest of a child in state custody before the court and other settings.
- **B.** "The CASA Network" Refers to all Texas CASA member programs throughout the state of Texas.
- C. Collaborative Family Engagement (CFE), is an integrated or embedded approach that establishes a true team between CASA and the Texas Child Protective Service (CPS) to work together to locate and engage relatives of children currently in state custody. This CFE team will share the work and every success will be a cooperative achievement.
- **D.** "Mexican Minor" means an unmarried individual, under the age of eighteen, who:
  - Was born in Mexico;
  - b. Is a national of Mexico and other countries as long as one of those countries is not the United States of America.
- **E.** "Minor of Mexican origin" means an unmarried individual, under the age of eighteen, born in the United States to at least one parent of Mexican nationality.

- **F.** "Mexican Family" means a family with at least one parent who was either born and/or currently resides in Mexico.
- **G.** "**DIF**" means the Agency for Integral Family Development. This is the agency in Mexico responsible for child protection.

#### III. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PARTIES

#### A. Texas CASA, to the extent of its capabilities:

- 1. Shall invite the Mexican Consulate, according to the consular jurisdiction in each identified CFE area, to the CFE initial training.
- 2. Shall invite and include the Mexican Consulate in CFE trainings, according to the area where such trainings take place and the consular jurisdiction.
- 3. Will encourage the CASA volunteer in the CFE Team to contact the Mexican Consulate in cases of Mexican minors of Mexican origin that are in CPS custody, to collaborate in tasks such as:
  - a. Find family members of Mexican nationality, whether in the United States or in Mexico. In order to do so, the CASA volunteer in the CFE team shall provide the Consulate with all relevant information that might be useful to locate a Mexican parent or a Mexican family member.
  - b. Collaborate in the process of engagement and work with Mexican minors or children of Mexican origin and their families, including visitation and interviews with the minors and their families, when considered appropriate. Also, the CASA volunteer in the CFE team shall alert Consular staff about Court hearings of cases of Mexican minors or children of Mexican origin, and promote the presence of Consular Staff.
- 4. In areas where CFE has not yet been implemented, Texas CASA will share the information about the services offered by the Mexican Consulate with the CASA network in order to encourage communication and collaboration to serve the best interest of Mexican minors or children of Mexican origin in CPS care.
- 5. Will promote that the CASA network include Mexican Consulates within their respective area to participate in local trainings when appropriate.

- B. Mexican Consulate, to the extent of its capabilities:
  - 1. Shall share with Texas CASA information about best practices for working with Mexican families including, but not limited to, cultural practices, communication and tools for engagement.
  - 2. Will provide information to Texas CASA and the CASA network about the services and programs offered by the Consulate that might benefit Mexican minors and their families.
  - Shall support the CASA volunteer in the CFE team by providing consultation and assistance to engage and work with Mexican minors or children of Mexican origin as applicable.
  - 4. Shall support the CASA volunteer in the CFE team by providing consultation and assistance to find, engage, and work with families, Mexican families, whether residing in the United States or Mexico, who may be able to provide a placement or otherwise support a child's permanent plan.
  - 5. Will assist the CFE team in obtaining the necessary documentation from Mexico regarding Mexican children and families, including certified copies of the birth records.
  - 6. When appropriate, the Consulate may contact DIF in order to procure the suitable socio-economic (home) studies of families in Mexico who may be eligible to obtain custody of a child. Upon receipt of the home studies, the Consulate will immediately transmit the information to the CFE team responsible for the case.
  - 7. When a child in CPS custody is placed in the custody of a person who lives in Mexico, the Consulate will assist the CFE team in the implementation of the necessary coordination measures to carry out the repatriation or placement of said child, procuring their welfare and providing them with all the necessary services.

#### IV. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. Texas CASA will serve as a point of contact for questions regarding CFE related statewide issues. For the purpose of this MOU, Texas CASA designates its address as the one located at 1501 West Anderson Lane, Suite B-2, Austin, Texas 78757, and the telephone number (512) 473-2627.

2. Texas CASA and the Consulate will write a joint media release regarding the MOU and collaboration between Texas CASA and Mexican Consular Network in Texas.

#### V. PRIVILEGES AND IMMUNITIES

Nothing contained in this MOU shall constitute or be construed as an express or implied waiver of the rights, privileges and immunities that the Vienna Convention on Consular Relations confers to the Consulate; nor implies, under any circumstances, that there is or there could be an employment relationship between the Consulate and/or its agents and employees and the Texas CASA and/or its agents and employees.

#### VI. DISPUTE RESOLUTION

Any dispute arising from the interpretation or application of this MOU shall be resolved by the parties through a mutual written agreement, product of a good faith negotiation process.

#### VII. MUTUAL EXCHANGE OF CONTACT INFORMATION

The Consulate and Texas CASA will exchange the names, titles, and contact information for designated staff to contact for issues relating to this MOU, and will update that information as necessary.

The Consulate will provide a list with the information of the Consulates of Mexico in Texas, including the name, title and contact information of the designated staff to contact for issues relating to this MOU. (Annex 1)

Texas CASA will provide a list with the information of the CFE areas and the name, title and contact information for the appropriate staff to contact for issues relating to this MOU. It will also provide a list of the CASA network programs as well as their contact information on an annual basis. (Annex 2 and 3)

#### VIII. CONTACT BY CONSULATE

Notwithstanding the provisions set forth in this MOU, the Parties acknowledge that the Consulate may contact, at any time, the Department of Family and Protective Services Office of General Counsel, the Court Appointed Special Advocate and/or Office of Attorney General of the State of Texas.

#### IX. AMENDMENT

This MOU may be modified at any time. Any changes, deletions, extensions, or amendments to this MOU will be in writing and signed by the Parties.

#### X. ENTRY INTO FORCE AND TERMINATION

This MOU shall enter into force from the date of its signature and shall continue in effect until either party decides to terminate it, by providing a ninety (90) days written notice to the other Party.

The undersigned Parties certify that they have the signatory authority to bind their respective Party to the terms and conditions of this MOU. This MOU is in duplicate in both Spanish and English languages. All signed copies are equally authentic.
