Episode Content

Episode 1 - DEFINE

In this episode, students will learn the basic definition of human trafficking and that it may include more than they thought.

Episode 2 - REVEAL

This episode uncovers traffickers' tactics, helping students recognize unhealthy relationships and potentially dangerous situations.

Episode 3 - EXPOSE

Demand fuels human trafficking. This episode exposes the ways our culture creates demand and offers inspiration for powerful changes.

Episode 4 - EMPOWER

In this episode, students learn skills to stay safe and simple strategies to get help when needed.

Episode 5 - ENGAGE

The curriculum ends here but this is just the beginning of their journey as students realize their potential to create lasting change in their communities and cultivate worlds where trafficking is a thing of the past.

Requesting Access

- Visit <u>unboundnow.org/youthprevention</u> to complete the application. Even if you only want to preview *Sentinels* 1:1, you will still need to complete the application process.
- 2. Upon approval, you will be emailed a link to log in and prompted to create your own password to access *Sentinels* 1:1 online. This link will be sent to the email provided on your *Sentinels* 1:1 application.
- 3. Once you have created your login, you can access Sentinels 1:1 at any time by visiting learn.unboundnow.org/courses/
- 4. <u>Before you are able to view</u> *Sentinels* 1:1 content, you will be required to complete the User Agreement. Even if you have not decided to implement *Sentinels* 1:1 with your student, we request that you complete the User Agreement form—this is not a commitment to implement *Sentinels* 1:1.

Before sharing Episode 1 with your student, please have them complete the Pre-*Sentinels* Student Survey to assess their current understanding of human trafficking.

This material can be printed and distributed beforehand or shared digitally.

AFTER SENTINELS
