Through CFE, we aim to:

- Strengthen collaboration
- Model a team-based approach
- Enhance CASA advocacy
- Increase child and family voice in planning and decision-making
- Increase the number of supportive, non-paid people in a child's life long-term (their network)
- Impact well-being factors for children in foster care

Greater collaboration between stakeholders to involve families and build networks



CULTIVATE

Access to connection, engagement and searching tools to engage and find family/important relationships

CONVENE

Families and their support network come together for family meetings



CONNECT

A lifetime network of supportive relationships is formed for the child and their family

CFE is a team-based approach between CASA and CPS, as well as the SSCC's to engage, find and work with family members and fictive kin in the creation and development of a lifetime network for young people in the foster care system.





Texas CASA is diligently working with local CASA programs to ensure we accurately represent this number in FY24 and moving forward. **73 out of 74 CASA programs are involved in CFE, as CASA of Travis County utilizes a different family engagement approach.
