- VFC has two types of volunteers: CASA and ROAR volunteers.
  - CASA these volunteers complete extensive training and background checks; they advocate on behalf of children assigned to our program
  - ROAR All non-case-related volunteer activities fall under the umbrella of "VFC ROAR." ROAR stands for Recruitment, Outreach & Advocacy Representatives: ROAR volunteers help with events like community presentations, fundraising activities, behind-the-scenes tasks and more!
